Impressioning of pin tumbler and disc tumbler locks is the one of a few skills that are indigenous to locksmithing. This class will cover the theory and techniques used to impression a working key from various types of locks. The student will become familiar with the tools and terminology used in impressioning. Students will have hands on instruction and practice on all types of locks, including pin and disc tumbler. The student will also learn to recognize some of the hazards of impressioning certain locks.
