WHO

The **LSA** membership is comprised of individuals directly involved in the physical security profession, who are interested in keeping up to date and learning more about their profession. The range of experience goes from the novice or beginner to the experienced veteran. **LSA** is a regional locksmith association with the majority of members centered around southeast Michigan.

GOAL

LSA aims to keep its locksmith members up to date and informed about security products and service procedures. With monthly membership meetings, guest speakers from the industry visit us and provide knowledge and technical product information. **LSA** sponsors some classes and also keeps members informed about security related classes that are offered by other security related groups or organizations.

WHEN AND WHERE

For the present, **Locksmith Security Association** meets on the second Thursday of the month from September to June in the metro Detroit area in southeast Michigan.
